Creams

IMPORTANT: You MUST do a patch test before using each of these products on your guinea

HOW TO DO A PATCH TEST: rub some of the product into a small area of skin on the back of the ear and just underneath where there is no hair. Check every couple of hours to ensure that there is no redness or irritation up to 8 hours after application. In the unlikely event that there is redness or irritation at any time, remove the product immediately. Please also let me know so that I can provide you with an alternative solution.

Super Souffle

A lovely rich but light cream with Avocado and Calendula Vegetable Oils to help moisturize crusty skin where there is a bad fungal skin problem. Easily absorbed, it can soften crusts and make them easier to remove. It can also help to prevent dry skin from flaking everywhere.

Apply the cream two or three times a day until the skin condition improves. Can be used on guineas of all ages and on pregnant sows – no Essential Oils are used in this product.

Galen's Garden Green Cream

- **DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT ON PREGNANT SOWS**

A soothing cream for minor sores, safe to use around the nose and mouth area. Especially useful for crusty mouths. Mouth sores can be caused by a bacterial or fungal infection. With Green Cream it doesn't matter what the cause is as both types of problem can be helped and you should see an improvement in just a few days.

YOU DO NOT NEED TO REMOVE THE SCABS BEFORE APPLYING THE CREAM. This is recommended on some sites, but is painful for the guinea and not nice for the human. The Green Cream will soften the scabs and they will come off in their own time.

Apply two or three times daily until the condition improves. The easiest and most hygienic method of application is using a cotton bud. Once the scabs have fallen off, keep applying the cream for 7-10 days to help prevent re-infection.
