Lotions & Creams

IMPORTANT: You MUST do a patch test before using each of these products on your guinea

HOW TO DO A PATCH TEST: rub some of the product into a small area of skin on the back of the ear and just underneath where there is no hair. Check every couple of hours to ensure that there is no redness or irritation up to 8 hours after application. In the unlikely event that there is redness or irritation at any time, remove the product immediately. Please also let me know so that I can provide you with an alternative solution.

Lotion: Lavender & Myrrh / Manuka

DO NOT USE ON PREGNANT SOWS.

Our Lotions have been designed for use in-between Oil Soaks to help your guinea's skin. The Lotion is light, non-greasy and easily absorbed by the skin. It has also been successfully used on guineas under 12 weeks old when a Melt cannot be used because the guinea is too young. Lotions are particularly effective on fungal ears and around the eye area, and can also be used on small fungal areas where a Melt is not required.

Apply a small amount to the affected area twice a day, and rub it in gently avoiding the eyes and mouth. You should expect to see an improvement in the skin within 7 days. Manuka has proved to be very effective for fungal skin problems, but where there is very dry / cracked skin the Lotion with Myrrh would be more appropriate.

Cocoa Butter Cream With Lavender

DO NOT USE ON PREGNANT SOWS.

CONTAINS NUT OIL – DO NOT USE IF YOU HAVE ANY NUT ALLERGIES.

Store in a cool place – if the weather is very warm, pop it in the fridge.

This is a very rich, heavy-duty emollient cream with Cocoa Butter, Shea Butter, Vegetable Oils and Lavender Essential Oil. It melts on contact with the skin and is designed to soothe and moisturise very dry skin. It is particularly effective where there is a bad fungal skin problem with bald patches. The cream keeps the skin moisturised, and helps to prevent the dry skin from flaking everywhere.

Where there is a severe fungal problem with crusts, this cream can help to soften the crusty areas before you attempt to give your guinea a shampoo. The Lavender contained in the cream can also help to calm them down, and is especially useful if your guinea is fitting. Apply once or twice daily depending on how dry the skin is, avoiding the eyes and mouth. This cream can be applied:

- to very crusty guineas before you attempt a shampoo
- to damp skin immediately after shampooing
- in-between shampoos to keep the skin moisturised where there is a lot of crusting
- to guineas with sore / cracked feet
- to guineas with very dry or crusty ears / nipples

Super Souffle

A lovely rich but light cream with Avocado and Calendula Vegetable Oils to help moisturize crusty skin where there is a bad fungal skin problem. Easily absorbed, it can soften crusts and make them easier to remove. It can also help to prevent dry skin from flaking everywhere. Apply the cream two or three times a day until the skin condition improves. Safe to use on all guineas of all ages and on pregnant sows – no Essential Oils are used in this product.
