### **Pregnant Sow Products**

We've created 4 products especially for pregnant sows with Fungal skin problems that do not contain any Essential Oils. We don't recommend that you use any products containing Essential Oils during piggy pregnancy as they haven't been tested for safety.

**IMPORTANT: You MUST do a patch test before using the Gel / Lotion / Cream on your guinea.**

**HOW TO DO A PATCH TEST:** rub some of the product into a small area of skin on the back of the ear and just underneath where there is no hair. Check every couple of hours to ensure that there is no redness or irritation up to 8 hours after application. In the unlikely even that there is redness or irritation at any time, remove the product immediately. Please also let me know so that I can provide you with an alternative solution.

### **Shampoo For Pregnant Sows**

Kind and gentle to your guinea's skin during pregnancy. This is the same shampoo base that we use for our Conditioning Shampoo, but without the Essential Oils.

1. Wet your guinea, put a strip of shampoo down her spine and massage in gently. Don't forget the ears and face need cleaning too! Scrape off some foam from the guinea's body and use the foam (not the shampoo) to massage gently into both sides of their ears and around the nose / face. Be careful not to get shampoo in their eyes or mouth. Rinse well.
2. Shampoo a second time and again, include the ears and face. Leave on for 3 to 4 minutes and rinse thoroughly.
3. Whether you leave your guinea to dry naturally or use a hairdryer on a low heat, please ensure that your guinea is kept warm and is completely dry before putting her back in her cage (especially in the winter).

### **Tamanu Gel**

Tamanu Gel has been designed to help pregnant sows with fungal skin problems. It is gentle and soothing, but contains no essential oils. Apply the gel two or three times daily until the condition improves. **CONTAINS NUT OIL: DO NOT USE if you have a NUT ALLERGY.**

### **Lotion For Pregnant Sows**

This Lotion has been designed especially for pregnant sows and contains no Essential Oils. A small amount is applied twice daily and rubbed gently into the skin. Lotions are particularly effective on fungal ears and around the eye area, and can also be used on other small fungal areas. **CONTAINS NUT OIL: DO NOT USE if you have a NUT ALLERGY.**

### **Super Souffle Cream**

A lovely rich but light cream with Avocado and Calendula Vegetable Oils to help moisturize crusty skin where there is a bad fungal skin problem. Easily absorbed, it can soften crusts and make them easier to remove. It can also help to prevent dry skin from flaking everywhere. Apply the cream two or three times a day until the skin condition improves.

### **Aloe Vera Gel**

Plain gel, no Essential Oils, so safe to use on pregnant sows. It is soothing, cooling and can help to reduce heat and redness in the skin.
