Thank you for taking some of the Gorgeous Guineas products for a test drive. Please read the instructions below before using these products.

SHAMPOOS

- **DO NOT USE ANY OF THESE SHAMPOOS ON PREGNANT SOWS.**
- **DO NOT USE SHAMPOOS ON THE SAME DAY AS WORMING / USING IVOMEC ON YOUR GUINEA –** leave 48 hours in between using these drugs and applying the shampoo.
- **For guineas under 12 weeks of age, use the Mini-Pig Shampoo.**

Conditioning Shampoos (Original 4 Oil, LTT & Lavender, Lavender, Posh 'n' Go, Just For Boars, EasiRinse)

Wet your guinea, put a strip of shampoo down their spine and massage in well. Don't forget the ears and face need cleaning too! Scrape off some foam from the guinea's body and use the foam (not the shampoo) to massage gently into both sides of their ears, and around their face / nose. Be careful not to get shampoo in their eyes or mouth. Rinse well. Shampoo your guinea twice and leave the second shampoo on for 3-4 minutes. Rinse off thoroughly and dry your guinea. Please ensure that your guinea is kept warm and is completely dry (especially in the winter) before putting him back in his **freshly cleaned cage**.

Mini-Pig Shampoo

Shampoo once only, rinse off straight away and dry your guinea as above.

Therapeutic Shampoos (Manuka & Neem / Lice 'n' Easy)

Shampoo your guinea twice (as above) and leave the second shampoo on for 5 minutes. Rinse off thoroughly and dry your guinea. Please ensure that your guinea is kept warm and is completely dry before putting him back in his cage (especially in the winter).

When you are using the Lice 'n' Easy shampoo, most of the Lice should be washed away with the first shampoo. One week later, repeat the two shampoos and any remaining Lice / Nits should disappear. If you have had a particularly heavy infestation, you may need to shampoo again after another week, but this is rarely required.

CREAMS, GELS & LOTIONS

YOU MUST DO A PATCH TEST BEFORE USING ANY OF THESE PRODUCTS ON YOUR GUINEA.

How to do a patch test: rub some of the product into a small area of skin on the back of the ear and just underneath where there is no hair. Check every couple of hours to ensure that there is no redness or irritation up to 8 hours after application. In the unlikely even that there is redness or irritation at any time, remove the product immediately. Please also let me know so that I can provide you with an alternative solution.

Lotions: **DO NOT USE Manuka / Lavender & Myrrh ON PREGNANT SOWS.**

Apply to the affected areas twice daily. Continue until the condition improves (usually within 7 days). Once the skin is looking better, keep applying the lotion for another week as fungal problems often recur if you stop too soon.

Gels: **ONLY THE ALOE VERA GEL IS SUITABLE FOR USE ON PREGNANT SOWS.**

Apply to the affected areas two or three times a day until the condition improves.

Creams: **ONLY THE SUPER SOUFFLE CREAM IS SUITABLE FOR USE ON PREGNANT SOWS.**

Apply to the affected areas two or three times a day until the condition improves.

Perfect Paws Ointment: Apply to the feet twice a day and massage in gently. Continue until the area is soft again and any cracks have healed.
